THE SMALL-SPACE UTILITY PLAN

Measure, zone, and organize a compact home without buying more clutter.

STEP 1

Start with pressure points

Map the five places where daily items pile up, block movement, or disappear. Fix the repeated friction before choosing containers.

What exact problem or task does this address?

What measurement, evidence, or instruction must be verified?

What limitation would make this the wrong choice?

UTILITY GATE

- ☐ Clears a repeated bottleneck
- ☐ Fits measured usable space
- ☐ Keeps daily items within reach
- ☐ Does not block doors or ventilation

STEP 2

Measure usable volume

Record width, depth, height, door swing, outlets, ventilation, and the hand clearance needed to retrieve an item safely.

WORK THE PAGE

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UTILITY GATE

- ☐ Fits measured usable space
- ☐ Keeps daily items within reach
- ☐ Does not block doors or ventilation
- ☐ Can be cleaned without dismantling

STEP 3

Assign one job per zone

Give each shelf, drawer, hook, or cart a single purpose. Mixed zones become invisible storage and invite duplicate purchases.

WORK THE PAGE

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UTILITY GATE

- ☐ Keeps daily items within reach
- ☐ Does not block doors or ventilation
- ☐ Can be cleaned without dismantling
- ☐ Has a clear removal plan

STEP 4

Choose reversible tools

Prefer risers, hooks, dividers, and carts that can move when the room changes. Verify load limits and mounting requirements.

- ☐ Clears a repeated bottleneck

STEP 5

Run the 30-day reset

Remove one low-use item for every organizer added. Recheck access, cleanup time, and visual noise after thirty days.
